












#### Ph.D. Boutheina Gharbi, a success story of a Tunisian entrepreneur



Born and raised in Sfax, one of the most well-known Tunisian southern cities to have the largest olive oil industry and the largest olive continual agricultural forest in the world. He grew up between olive oil mills and what marked his childhood was a simple question that will lead him today to be considered as one of the potential successful entrepreneurs:
