







## 9 MUNICIPALITIES/LOCAL AUTHORITIES WILL UPDATE THEIR ENERGY EFFICIENCY PLANS THANKS TO EU-FUNDED SEACAP 4 SDG PROJECT

SEACAP 4 SDG presents the official first Municipalities/Local Authorities selected to update energy-mix efficiency plans.

## November 2022

SEACAP 4 SDG project, funded under ENI CBC MED Programme, publishes the list with the first selected Municipalities and Local Authorities selected for receiving technical support by an external entity for obtaining an updated Sustainable Energy Access and Climate Action Plan (SEACAP), or an equivalent energy-mix efficiency plan.

On the 29<sup>th</sup> November, SEACAP 4 SDG project will celebrate the first selected Municipalities/Local Authorities with a mid-term event in Beirut, hosted within Beirut Energy Week (28-30<sup>th</sup> November), and streamed online to all project partners and their stakeholders. The event will be the opportunity to present the list of first Municipalities/Local Authorities composed by: Municipality of Lloret de Mar (Spain), Municipality of Aigialeia (Greece), Municipality of Naples (Italy), Aqaba Special Economic Zone Authority (Jordan), Municipality of Jdeideh El Chouf (Lebanon), Municipality of Sax (Spain), Municipality of Bizerte (Tunisie), Alexandria Water Company (Egypt). In the coming weeks, the name of last Municipality/Local Authority will also be communicated, thus completing the final list.

Jdeideh El Chouf municipality from Lebanon will open a slot dedicated to the exchange with selected Municipalities/Local Authorities and external entities that will participate online in order to explain their feedback or suggestion regarding the implementation of the proposed mechanism in country partners.

Moreover, in the SEACAP 4 SDG project, 4 municipalities from the Mediterranean Southern Shore will also receive technical support for the implementation of innovative solutions and tools for the energy refurbishment of an education or health buildings.

The SEACAP 4 SDG project, within ENI CBC MED Programme, started on December 2021. The project will last 18 months and has a total budget of  $\le$  1 million, 90% of which is funded by the European Union.
