SEACAP 4 SDG OFFICIALLY LAUNCHES THE CALL FOR INTEREST FOR MUNICIPALITIES TO RECEIVE FREE SUPPORT FOR THE ENERGY REFURBISHMENT OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS

On 7 July 2022, during an Information seminar held in Aqaba (Jordan) and online, the SEACAP 4 SDG project officially presented and launched the **Call for Interest** dedicated to Municipalities and Local Authorities of the Mediterranean area interested in receiving technical support for the implementation of innovative solutions and tools for the **energy refurbishment of public buildings, notably in the education and health sectors.**

In fact, one of the main objectives of the SEACAP 4 SDG project, is to provide support within the field of sustainable energy with a Toolkit of selected outcomes. In this regard, thanks to the support of selected **external entities and specific training sessions**, the Municipalities and Local Authorities will have the opportunity to analyse the actions needed **to boost the execution of long-term energy plans** by analysing the implementation of measures **to improve the energy performance of buildings** and achieve energy savings.

The SEACAP 4 SDG project, within ENI CBC MED Programme, started on December 2021. The project will last 18 months and has a total budget of € 1 million, 90% of which is funded by the European Union.
