Regulatory and Legal Complexities

- Align and optimise existing regional policies in green and circular economy, blue economy, and sustainable agriculture
- Build **strong legislative** frameworks that define circularity across all sectors, coordinate sectorial efforts, and gradually make circular practices the prevailing mode in the economy
- Enhance dialogue among relevant stakeholders and promote skills transfer between countries

Social Inclusion and Youth Empowerment

- Promote youth protagonism at all levels through participatory methods and youth quotas in executive positions
- Improve working conditions for young people and women in agriculture, emphasizing social protection and gender-responsive **strategies** to bridge the gender gap
- Build employment policies to expand career guidance, enhance entrepreneurial skills, offer consistent education and adapt learning schemes to the current needs

Sustainable Economy

- Strengthen key sectors in Green and Circular Economy with fiscal policies supporting small and medium-sized enterprises
- Foster Sustainable Agriculture by addressing current consumption and distribution patterns and strengthening community-territory relationship
- Enhance Blue Economy profession appeal by focusing on and adapting to the needs of young citizens
