1. Introduction

This Dynamization Toolkit has been elaborated to provide an overview of how the Mediterranean Co-production Lab can be dynamised, so that future facilitators can make use of it. This document only provides general guidelines that can be expanded with the creativity of those doing this work.

2. Platform resources

The Mediterranean Co-production Lab is designed to foster collaboration and innovation to address complex societal challenges in the Mediterranean. To achieve this, this platform seeks to **build a community** where people and organisations can work together, **exchange knowledge**, **experiment** and **learn collectively**. Some of the main resources available on the platform are as follows:

Community

• A **space to interact** with other members of the community, participate in real-time discussions, ask questions and share opinions on topics related to the lab's mission. You can interact through the main forum with all members, through specific groups or directly with one or several users through private chat.


Courses

• **Learning courses** on co-production, social and solidarity economy, social innovation, creation of social entrepreneurship ecosystems, etc. are available free of charge for registered users. They can be taken both online and offline. Upon completion of the course, the user will receive a certificate of completion.

Subgrants

• Specific section for sharing **funding opportunities and subgrants**.





• An up-to-date **calendar of events** related to social policy, co-production, and social innovation in the Mediterranean region.

3. Tips for building a vibrant community

Maintaining an active and dynamic Community of Practice requires dedication and time on a regular basis. Make sure that all members of the platform feel invited to make use of the platform and share information of interest to the community. Here is a list of ideas and suggestions of things you can share to **generate activity and inspire** the rest of the community:

- News of interest, articles, conferences
- Special dates
- Testimonials, tips, recommendations, mistakes to learn from...
- Inspiring stories, before and after projects,
- New job offer
- Team building campaign
- Interesting courses and trainings
- Ouestions
- Relevant quotes

4. Gamification: points and status

Participation in the platform is encouraged through a gamification system that consists of **rewarding users by earning points** according to different actions. In this way, as users become more and more involved in the platform, their score increases and so does their status. Here is a list of the points awarded for each of the actions:

- 100 MED Points for **registering**
- 100 MED Points for **completing your profile**
- 100 MED Points for **completing a course**
- 30 MED Points for sending an email invitation
- 20 MED Points for changing profile avatar (1 time)



- 20 MED Points for changing cover image (1 time)
- 20 MED Points for **updating profile information (1 time)**
- 20 MED Points for **publishing a post**
- 10 MED Points for receiving 20 likes
- 5 MED Points for **logging in each day**
- 5 MED Points for **posting**
- 2 MED Points for **commenting**
- 1 MED Points for **liking a post**

While these courses are currently free of charge, in the future, avenues could be explored for partners to offer their own courses for a fee, which could be charged on MedPoints in order to promote it as a form of exchange, or in other currencies.
